

MALAYSIA ADDENDUM TO
KNOWLES
PURCHASE ORDER TERMS AND CONDITIONS

(MALAYSIA)

1. **Introduction.** This Addendum to Purchase Order Terms and Conditions (the “Addendum”) supplements the Knowles Purchase Order Terms and Conditions (the “Conditions”). Terms not defined herein shall have the same meaning as in the Conditions. In case of any conflict between this Addendum and the Conditions, this Addendum shall prevail.

2. **Compliance with Laws and Regulations.** Amending Clause 14.5 of the Conditions, SUPPLIER shall maintain accurate books and records of the transactions contemplated under the Contract Documents and shall retain such records for a period of seven (7) years following the last delivery of Products or Services. CUSTOMER shall have the right, on reasonable notice, to examine such records to verify compliance with this Section. SUPPLIER shall comply with all applicable anti-corruption laws, including the FCPA, in performing its obligations under each of the Contract Documents.

3. **Governing Law.** Amending Clause 25 of the Conditions, the Contract Documents shall be construed in accordance with the laws of the Malaysia, and the rights and liabilities of the parties hereto, including any assignees, shall be determined in accordance with the laws of Malaysia. The United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods shall not apply to the transactions contemplated by the Contract Documents.
